

Safety Professional

Philadelphia area industrial heavy site contractor has a need for an experienced safety professional.

Candidate must be familiar with Process Safety Management protocols, as well as the special requirements demanded of industrial / manufacturing / refinery settings.

OSHA 40 Hour training, Hazardous Operator and 30 Hour Construction Safety Training are required. Intimate familiarity with OSHA General Industry Standards (1910) as well as Construction Standards (1926) is also required. Minimum level of experience is 5 years in the above referenced work settings. Certified CSP or CHST may substitute for experience.

Safety auditing will be a daily requirement, as will supporting our work crews in managing and maintaining an adequate supply of required PPE and any other tools / equipment required to safely complete their tasks. Responsible for insuring compliance with company safety policies including monitoring completion of daily JSA's.

The work week will consist of a minimum 40 hours, with OT as required by the ongoing efforts of our crews and their scope of work.

Other duties may include, preparing job site safety audits, preparing Site Specific Safety Plans as needed, preparing weekly tool box safety meetings, Update company Safety Program, Respond to accidents and Prepare Accident Investigation Reports. Represent company at meetings with customers. Contact with employees and insurance company regarding the follow up of injuries.

Salary will be commensurate with experience. Benefits may include vacation, health insurance, and participation in company profit share plan.
