Subject: Platform Leveling

Allowable Hours: 60 minutes

Issue:

Genie Industries has become aware of instances where the platform leveling valve, utilized in the above referenced machines, malfunctions due to contamination of the hydraulic oil. **A platform leveling valve that malfunctions can cause the platform to become unlevel.**

Actions Required:

- 1 Locate all machines within the models and serial ranges referenced above.
- 2 Order the Platform Leveling Valve Kit PN 1261518.
- 3 Using the installation instructions included in the kit, install the Leveling Valve Kit on your machine.

Installation of the kit must take place as soon as possible but no later than 30 days from receipt of the kit.

- 4 Fill out and sign the completion form attached to the installation instructions and return to Genie. This will serve as verification that you have completed this Safety Notice.

Continued Use Instructions:

All machine operators and users must be notified of these continued use requirements.

The machine may remain in service until this Safety Notice is completed by following the requirements below:

If platform becomes unlevel, do the following:

- a Immediately disengage the foot switch.
Note: Do not re-engage the foot switch. Re-engaging the foot switch can cause the platform to move further out of level.
- b Shut off the engine.
- c Remove the operator from the platform.
- d Lower the platform using the ground controls.
- e Tag and remove the machine from service until this Safety Notice has been completed.
