- Support incident investigations.
- Engage with Safety DRIs and EHS support on construction projects to provide leadership and ensure quality of support.
- Participate in project and regional performance reviews.
- Participate in EHS in Design sessions within region.
- Proactively engage with Regional Directors to forecast programmatic and project level safety risks and work with teams to address emerging risks.
- Facilitate in region forums with internal and external partners to enhance safety communications, lessons learned and best practice sharing, and safe delivery.
- Assist in performing deep dive safety reviews and listening tours for targeted safety risk topics as requested by CoE.
- Assist in the preparation of presentations, including high visibility/time sensitive ones, for leadership.
- Present data and targeted awareness presentations.
- Develop and issue targeted safety campaign materials for project teams to use.
- Develop and issue safety related lessons learned, best practices, and innovative solutions as requested by CoE.
